**CHAPTER SIX: Credentials and Workplace Culture**

**CHAPTER SEVEN: Job Search Skills**

The sessions are hosted by professionals from within the community who share information and advice from their field of expertise. Speakers include: HR specialists, business owners, civic leaders, representatives from the Alberta Health Services, Calgary Police, banking professionals, and many others.

## CONTENT

The topics of the Calgary: A New Chapter orientation sessions provide newcomers with information about the city of Calgary, the local education system, finances and banking, recreational and volunteer opportunities, community service, the legal system, Canadian workplace culture and employment preparation.

Upon completion of the sessions, each participant will have access to the resources posted on the Calgary: A New Chapter website which will assist them in designing their own settlement plan.
